SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships of \$500 and \$1,000 are available for students in LEVELS 1, 2 and 3.

In addition, Level 3 students who apply for scholarships are eligible to receive **Pin Awards** of up to \$100 toward the purchase of their graduation pin.

These competitive scholarships are based on academic and clinical achievement, school and community involvement, and faculty recommendations. Financial need is not a criteria. We are looking for outstanding student nurses.

DEADLINE TO APPLY: Tuesday, May 10, 2022, at 10am

Please read ALL these instructions carefully!

TO BE ELIGIBLE:

You must be currently enrolled in the Charity School of Nursing RN program and have a minimum **2.7 cumulative nursing average** (this is your average in the classes required for the nursing major, NOT the same thing as your Delgado GPA). In addition, you must be enrolled in Charity School of Nursing when awards are presented in the Fall 2022 semester.

TO APPLY:

1. Request letters of recommendation from your instructors. **Level 1 students** need a recommendation from ONE clinical instructor. **Level 2 and 3** need recommendations from TWO faculty members; at least one must be a clinical instructor. It is YOUR responsibility to request letters of recommendation from your instructors prior to the application deadline. (The instructors will submit their recommendations directly to the Alumni office.)
2. Sign up for a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee.
Interview Days will be Wednesday, May 11 and Thursday, May 12, 2022.

Select "May 2022 Scholarship Interviews," click on either May 11 or May 12, and then choose the time that you want. Slots are 30 minutes. Please sign up **no later than 10:00am on May 10, 2022.**

3. Email your application to the Alumni Office at: chsnaaoffice@gmail.com (see *Application Instructions* on next page). **Your application must be submitted by email no later than 10:00am on May 10, 2022.** Applications received after the deadline will not be accepted.
You don't have to wait until the deadline - you can apply as early as you like.
4. **Once you receive your final grades**, fill out the attached **Grade Report Sheet** and email it to the Alumni Office at: chsnaaoffice@gmail.com. Please type "Scholarship Application Grades" in the subject line.
Please do NOT send incomplete grades reports – wait until you have ALL your grades for the Spring 2022 semester.

What happens then?

You will be emailed by the Alumni Office no later than 6pm on May 10 to confirm your application and let you know where interviews will take place at the School of Nursing. That email will let you know the room number.

Scholarships will be awarded in Fall 2022, some time **after** the 14th day of classes. If the school holds their Promotion and Awards Ceremony (usually held about three weeks after classes begin) awards will be presented there. If the Ceremony is not held, awards will be mailed. All applicants will be emailed by the Alumni Office regarding the results.

Please type "Scholarship Application question" in the subject line.

Application instructions:

At the top of the page, type:

- Your name
- Your postal mailing address *including city and zipcode*
- The BEST email address to reach you
- The BEST phone number to reach you
- Your current Level in school (*in April 2022, not next semester*)
- The name and email address of each instructor you are asking to write a recommendation.
At least ONE must be a clinical instructor. (Level 1 students need only one letter.)

Then, tell us about yourself.

We want to know who you are! Please include ANY information that you think would be helpful to the committee in deciding whether to give you a scholarship.

The following questions are only meant to help you get started. You do NOT need to answer them specifically. More information is better!

Think about: *Are you involved in any school activities or organizations? Have you held any offices, been involved in special projects or activities on campus? Are you involved in community activities, particularly any related to healthcare? Any military service? Have you been cited by the Honors Committee of the Faculty Association? Have you received any clinical excellence awards, honors or citations at school or in the community?*

Think about: *What are your goals? Do you plan to continue your education?*

Think about: *Why would receiving a scholarship be important to you? Everyone could use an extra \$500, and the award decisions are NOT based on financial need. Is there an educational or profession-building opportunity a scholarship would allow you?*

Think about: *Is there any information that you would like us to know? Are there any special challenges you have faced as a nursing student? This is your opportunity to tell us who you are and what inspires you. What did you do before nursing school? What experiences shaped your life? Why did you decide to be a nurse? What path brought you to where you are today? Where do you want to go in the future?*
