# **DEADLINE TO APPLY: Friday, Dec. 7, 2023**

Please read ALL these instructions carefully!

### **TO BE ELIGIBLE:**

#### You must:

- 1. Be currently enrolled in the Charity School of Nursing Transitions program,
- 2. Have a minimum B grade in your Transition courses with no "Un-sats", and
- 3. Be planning to enter Level 3 of the RN program in Spring 2024. (You must be enrolled in Level 3 of the RN program in the Spring 2024 semester.)

## TO APPLY:

- Email your Application Essay to: CharityAlumniScholarships@gmail.com (see Application Essay Instructions below). Your application essay must be submitted by email no later than midnight on Dec. 7, 2023. Essays received after the deadline will not be accepted. No exceptions.
  - You don't have to wait until the deadline you can apply as early as you like.
- Request letters of recommendation from: Ms. Wolff, your transitions clinical instructor,

AND

Your charge nurse (or similar direct supervisor) at your current LPN job.

Please ask your charge nurse to email their recommendation directly to the Alumni at: CharityAlumniScholarships@gmail.com by Dec 11, 2023.

- 3. Sign up for a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee.
  Interview Days will be <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>Dec. 12 through Thursday</u>, <u>Dec. 14</u>, <u>2023</u>.
  Schedule your interview online at: calendly.com/chsnalumni-scholarship-interviews
  Select <u>December 2023 Scholarship Interviews</u>, click on the date of your choice, and then choose the time that you want. Slots are 30 minutes. Please sign up no later than <u>Dec. 7</u>, <u>2023</u>.

- 4. Once you receive your final grades, fill out the attached **Grade Report Sheet** and email it to the Alumni at: **CharityAlumniScholarships@gmail.com**Please do NOT send an incomplete grade report WAIT until you have ALL your grades for the Fall 2023 semester. You can send your grades with your essay or as a separate email. If separate from your essay, please type "Grades" in the subject line.

## What happens then?

You will be emailed by the Alumni Office no later than noon on Dec. 10 to confirm your application and let you know the room where interviews will take place. The interviews will be held in the Ochsner Center. The email will also include a phone number to call in case you have problems on the day of your interview.

Scholarships will be awarded in the **Spring 2024 semester**, at the Promotion and Awards Ceremony (usually held at least a month after classes begin). All applicants will be emailed by the Alumni Office regarding the results. If the Ceremony is not held, awards will be mailed to the recipients.

# **Application Essay instructions:**

#### Email your essay to: CharityAlumniScholarships@gmail.com

You can send your essay in the body of the email, or attach a document. If you attach a document, it must be in Word or PDF format. Please do not double-space your essay.

#### At the top of the essay, type:

- Your name
- Your postal mailing address including city and zip code
- The BEST email address to reach you
- The BEST phone number to reach you
- Your current Level in school ("Transitions")
- o The name and email address of the supervisor you are asking to write a recommendation.

# Then, tell us about yourself.

We want to know who you are! Please include ANY information that you think would be helpful to the committee in deciding whether to give you a scholarship. The following questions are only meant to help you get started. You do NOT need to answer them specifically. More information is better! This is your opportunity to tell us who you are and what inspires you.

Think about: Are you involved in any school activities or organizations? Have you held any offices, been involved in special projects or activities on campus? Are you involved in community activities, particularly any related to healthcare? Any military service? Have you received recognition for any professional or academic achievements? Have you received any honors or citations in the community?

Think about: What are your goals? Do you plan to continue your education?

Think about: Why would receiving a scholarship be important to you? Everyone could use an extra \$500, but the award decisions are NOT based on financial need. Is there an educational or profession-building opportunity a scholarship would allow you?

Think about: Is there any information that you would like us to know? Are there any special challenges you have faced as a nursing student? What did you do before nursing school? What experiences shaped your life? Why did you decide to be a nurse? What path brought you to where you are today? Where do you want to go in the future?
